



It takes approximately 10 minutes to walk from the Visitors Centre to the lake. We recommend that you allow at least 1 hour to explore the gardens trails.

QUARRY GARDENS TRACKS
 Errol's Track links to Upper and Lower Tracks - these both link to the Kauri Walk - 2.1 kms Allow an hour. Steep steps in areas.

Please be aware of uneven surfaces and natural hazards.

QUARRY ARTS BUSH WALK
 Phoenix Grove & Kauri Walk link to Quarry Arts track & Coronation Reserve Tracks. 2.15kms from Q. Gardens to Q. Arts - Allow 2 hours for return trip. Steep steps.
